# Antique Arms Collectors Society of Australia








### History

Seven dedicated antique arms collectors formed the Society in 1956, their inaugural meeting held in a small storeroom over a chemist store on Canterbury road. They realised that by forming a formal society they could help in the preservation of Australia's historic arms for future generations.

Membership is now over 900 and the Society has affiliation with Sydney's Power House Museum.







#### **Aims**

The subject of members' interests has spread from Australian historic arms to arms and their accourtements from any era and from any area, world wide.

Our aim is to publicize our existence to assist in the locating, the collecting and the preservation of all antique arms. We also foster research into the manufacture, the history and the employment of those arms.





#### **Meetings**

Licensed collectors must have attendances at authorised society gatherings. The Society has regular monthly city meetings. Held at 8pm on the last Tuesday of every month at The Canada Bay Club, 4 William Street FIVEDOCK For those out-of-town, we have over twenty country chapters with meetings and meeting places arranged by the respective chapter convenors.

#### **Protection**

The legal protection of collector's rights and of the collections themselves is a foremost agenda for the Society's committee. Negotiating, lobbying and preparing presentations to members and Firearms Registry, in an attempt to maintain some sanity in the collecting laws.

#### **Publications**

A newsletter is circulated to members to keep them informed of meetings, passing news, chapter details and legislation updates. Articles of interest are always welcome.

The Society publishes a journal called "Arms Cavalcade" which showcases arms and accessories from society members.
